To Love a Child, Inc. Receives Grant from Soroptimist International of Saratoga County (SISC)

To Love a Child has been named a recipient of a Global Initiatives grant through Soroptimist International of Saratoga County (GISISC). GISISC began in 2012-13 through its commitment to increase support of programs that improve the lives of women and girls outside of Saratoga County. In doing so, SISC hopes to see a realization of the call to fulfill the second half of its mission statement -- improving the lives of women and girls throughout the world.

This three year grant of \$15,000 will be used to fund a capital project, the construction of a Women and Children's Center, in Chikandakubi, Zimbabwe. This project will enable 100 women, who will be directly involved in this project, to serve over 300 children the first year of production and mentor dozens of teenage girls on an ongoing basis. The "Women and Children's Center" will provide a location for women to sew, knit and embroider in order to earn an income. To Love a Child is currently in Phase 1 of this project.
